I was away during some Sundays and other passages may have been preached on, but this gives a flavour of what we have looked at so far, with more to come in September.

This is of course my take on these, and you may have a different perspective. Do look them up in your Bibles at home. The Psalms is roughly in the middle of the Bible. It once seemed to me that if I opened my Bible randomly I always seemed to end up in the Psalms, usually number 119 (look it up if unsure why!).

29<sup>th</sup> June – 109, Praying when facing an adversary.

 $6^{th}$  July – 30, The importance of singing in adversity.

13<sup>th</sup> July – 19, Pondering the natural world to learn about God and ourselves.

20<sup>th</sup> July – 23, The faithful shepherding love of God lasts forever.

27<sup>th</sup> July – 85, God is a forgiving God, always ready to hear us.
